**27 February, shared from the Blue Mountains command: Domestic Violence** affects many people in our community and is not something that occurs solely between a husband and wife. Do you know the definition of who is classed as being involved in domestic relationships? You may be surprised by the definition below

Domestic Violence (DV) involves anyone who is or has been in the past:

- \* Married
- \* Defacto relationship
- \* Relationship - being an intimate relationship (whether of a sexual nature or not)  
e.g. boyfriend or girlfriend
- \* Residing - have ever lived together in the same household e.g. house mates
- \* Residential - have ever lived as a long term resident in a residential facility e.g. nursing home, boarding school, etc (not a correctional or detention facility)
- \* Relying on care - have ever had a relationship involving dependance on the ongoing paid or unpaid care of a person
- \* Relative - such as parents, siblings, aunts, uncles, cousins and grandparents
- \* Kinship - in the case of an Aboriginal person or a Torres Strait Islander, is or has been part of the extended family or kin of the other person according to the Indigenous kinship system of the person's culture.
