The following relate to local issues in the Kuring gai Local Area Command.

Incident: Arrest and charge

Time/Date: About 9 pm on Friday the 21st

Place: Mildred avenue, Hornsby

Person 1: 23 year old male

Details: On the 19th of October a male was stabbed during a robbery in Mildred avenue, Hornsby the victim was treated at the RNSH. Police attended a unit in Mildred avenue on Friday night and arrested the 23 year old male who police are alleging is the offender. The male refused to be interviewed and was charged.

Court: The male was refused bail and is to appear at Court at a date yet to be set. He was charged with Robbery with wounding.

Incident: Supply drugs
Time/Date: About 7 pm on Friday the 21st
Place: Westfield Hornsby
Person: 16 year old male.

Details: The youth was in a toilet within Westfield at this time a security guard has heard a conversation which was suspicious and called police. Police have arrived soon after and spoke to all parties. The male was searched with police alleging 4 resealable bags containing green vegetable matter was found on the male. The male was arrested but refused to be interviewed he was charged.

Court: The male is to appear at the Hornsby Children's Court on the 10th of November charged with supply prohibited drug.

Incident: Steal from motor vehicle
Time/Date: 5 pm on Friday the 21st and 11 am on Sunday the 23rd
Place: Berowra Village Green, Berowra waters road, Berowra

Details: A Toyota Rav 4 was parked at the location and during the above times was broken into by unknown means. A Mobile phone, GPS and various CD's were taken the total value being about \$1,200.

Incident: Aggravated Break and Enter.
Time/Date: Between 6 pm and 10.30 pm on Friday the 21st
Place: Yirgella road East Killara

Details: The owner was home during the above times when unknown person/s have removed a fly screen and forced a window open, the main bedroom was entered and searched. At this stage nothing appears to have been stolen. The owner did not see or hear anything.

Incident: Break Enter & Steal

Time/Date: Between 6.30 pm and 7.50 pm on Sunday the 23rd

Place: Kallang road, Wahroonga

Details: Unknown person/s have broken into the home and ransacked it, An Ipad, Laptop, Camera and cash were stolen. The total value is an estimated \$2,100.

A number of inquiries are being made into the break in.

Police are appealing to witnesses who may have information relating to the above incident to contact Hornsby police on 9476 9799, or phone Crime Stoppers on 1800 333 000 to report any information relating to the matter anonymously.


Other News:
