Hornsby Police news, 26/9/11

The following relate to local issues in the Kuring gai/Hornsby Local Area Command:

Incident: Police pursuit
Time/Date: About 1.10pm on Saturday the 24th
Place: Pacific Highway Wahroonga to Turramurra
Vehicle 1: Commodore
Driver 1: 25 year old male

Details: Police observed the Commodore and a radar check showed an alleged speed of 87 km/h in the 60 km/h speed zone. The driver was eventually stopped in Turramurra and spoken to. The driver had an international license and did not know about lights and sirens which was why he did not stop (does now). He was given a ticket for exceeding the speed limit by more that 20 Km/h.

Incident: Police pursuit
Time/Date: About 10.38 pm on Friday the 23rd.
Place: F3 Wahroonga to Asquith
Vehicle 1: Commodore
Suspect: 36 year old male.

Details: Police observed the Commodore allegedly speeding on the F3. A speed check showed an alleged speed of 132 in the 80 speed zone. The commodore allegedly increased its speed in the 110 zone to an estimated 190km/h +. Lights and sirens were activated and the Commodore allegedly failed to stop and continued. It took the Mt Colah exit and eventually stopped in a nearby Asquith street. The driver fled the scene. A police dog tracked a scent through bushland. A male was stopped nearby and spoken to. Inquiries are continuing into the matter. The Commodore was towed to a secure location for analysis.

Incident: 5 car crash.

Time/Date: About 6.10pm on Friday the 23rd.

Place: Sherbrook road x Burdett street, Hornsby.

Details: 4 cars were stopped at a red traffic light. Early investigations reveal a 5th car was travelling along the road and the driver appears to have had an epileptic incident and allegedly lost consciousness. The car has then hit the last car causing a concertina effect with 4 cars in total being hit. The driver was taken to hospital as a precaution. Inquiries are continuing into the matter.

Incident: Stolen Car torched.

Time/Date: About 12.10 am on Saturday the 24th

Place: Kuring gai Chase road, Mt Colah.

Details: Fire brigade were called to the location due to a car on fire. At the scene a Hyundai was found to be well alight, the fire was put out in about 20 minutes. There were no rego plates on the car. However police managed to find the owner. The car was earlier stolen from the owners home. The car was valued at about \$5,000.

Incident: Break Enter & Steal

Time/Date: Between 11am on Thursday the 22nd and 2pm on Saturday the 24th

Place: Bruce avenue, Killara

Details: A nearly completed building complex was broken into by unknown person/s. 5 units were entered and numerous appliances were stolen including cook tops, ovens, driers and microwaves. All were Miele brand with values still to be tallied.
