Strike Force Better

Strike Force Better was formed to investigate a string of home burglaries on Sydney's north shore during which a large amount of property was stolen.

This property includes Australian and foreign currency, silver bullion, gold and silver jewellery, precious stones, antiques, heirlooms, firearms, and ammunition.

Below is a list of jewellery inscriptions on some of the recovered items. We are hoping to reunite these treasured pieces with their owners.

What if I recognise one of these inscriptions?

The following relate to local issues in the Kuring gai Local Area Command.

Incident: Middle range drink driving
Time/Date: About 2:50 pm on Tuesday the 21st
Place: Pacific Highway, Warrawee
Vehicle 1: Black Jeep 4x4
Driver 1: 25 year old male from the Nowra area

Details: Members of the public saw the Jeep drive onto a nature strip and stop this was on the Pacific highway Warrawee concerned about this 000 were called. Police soon after sighted the Jeep in the Lane Cove area. The Jeep was seen to allegedly weave in and out of traffic braking harshly and accelerating. The Jeep was stopped and the driver spoken to. A roadside breath test was allegedly positive for alcohol. A subsequent test gave a result of .126. Checks on the driver and car also revealed he was unlicensed and the Jeep had its registration cancelled. The driver was charged.

Court: The male is to appear at the Hornsby Local Court on the 15th of March charged with Driving with a Middle Range Prescribed Concentration of Alcohol, unlicensed driving and driving an unregistered and uninsured car.

Incident: Break Enter & Steal
Time/Date: Sometime between the 9th and the 21st of February, 2012.
Place: Fairbairn Ave, EAST KILLARA

Details: The owner was looking for her jewellery and found some items missing, a search of her home found a side door had been damaged from being forced open. In total approximately \$9,800 worth of jewellery had been stolen.

Police are appealing to witnesses who may have information relating to the above incident to contact Hornsby police on 9476 9799, or phone Crime Stoppers on 1800 333 000 to report any information relating to the matter

anonymously.

General warning and reminder

Over the past week several cars in the Asquith and Brooklyn area have been broken into for the sole purpose of stealing items within. Some of these cars had GPS units, one had a laptop computer a wallet with cash and cards. These incidents also result in damage to the cars which may cost hundreds of dollars to repair.

You can reduce your risk by following a few simple rules.

Park your car where possible in a well lit area or in a high use area.

Lock your car, install and use an alarm. (even at home)

Never leave anything of value in your car.

If you must leave anything in your car leave it in the boot area so it can't be seen.

Leave your glove box and console open to show there is nothing inside.

Don't leave blankets or clothes in the cabin area it may appear like they are covering goodies.
